JA Workforce Coaching - Ongoing, Remote

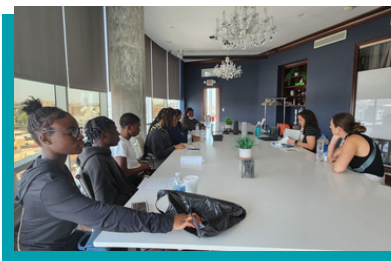
- **Individual remote opportunity, 12 weekly meetings**
- The power of coaching is a critical tool in developing the potential of young adults. This initiative, for youth between 16 and 21 who have a barrier to work/school, deploys age-appropriate workforce readiness resources that lead participants directly into a job or a career-focused educational or training program.
