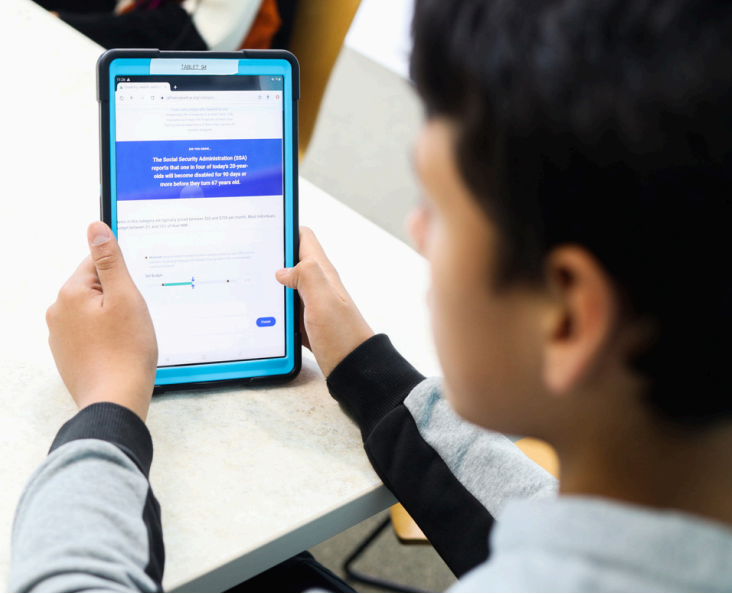
Finance Park® OVERVIEW

Wish you knew about managing money as a teen?

Youth deserve the chance to experience **JA Finance Park®**, one of Junior Achievement's signature learning experiences to teach students financial fluency and career exploration.

JA Finance Park combines in-class learning with a reality-based simulation, where students engage with volunteers and practice what they have learned in the classroom. Students are assigned hypothetical life scenarios, and as they visit the different booths in the simulation, they learn about the different categories that any adult would need to consider when developing a personal budget. This lays a strong foundation for young people to make educated financial decisions that last a lifetime.

ABOUT JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF SOUTHEASTERN PENNSYLVANIA

Finance Park® IN-CLASS LESSONS

Over 12 in-class lessons, and in alignment with national and state standards, **JA Finance Park curriculum covers topics such as:**

Income

Students recognize the fundamental role of income in managing their personal finances and how the decisions they make about education and career will have an impact on their potential income and quality of life.

Savings, Investing, and Risk Management

Students explore why saving money is critical, and they compare investments as a part of their overall financial planning. They examine risk and how insurance may help protect savings. They also examine risk and how insurance may help mitigate certain expenses.

Credit and Debit

Students compare financial institutions and their services. They weigh the advantages and disadvantages of debit and credit. Students will explore the role of credit scores and credit reporting on personal finances.

Careers

Students identify their career interests and goals and how they relate to future income. They set a career goal they will revisit at the end of the program.

Budget

Students discover the importance of spending money wisely and recognize a budget as a valuable tool.

After completing the in-class lessons, students visit the “simulation”, the culminating portion of the program. By interacting with JA staff, volunteers, and educators, young people gain:

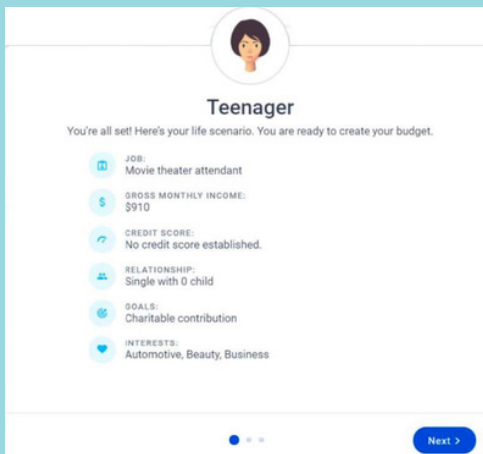
- **Hands-on Learning:** Immersive, reality-based decision-making
- **Practical Experience:** Understanding individual / family budgeting
- **Comprehensive Coverage:** Exposure to essential budgeting categories such as housing, utilities, food, transportation, banking, healthcare, securing loans, saving, planning for retirement, and philanthropy
- **Guided Assistance:** Support from knowledgeable personnel
- **Real-world Skills:** Preparation for future financial responsibilities

Imagine the benefits for young people of practicing being an adult for a day, understanding real-life circumstances, and safely planning for the future.

Finance Park® SIMULATION

During their visit to the **JA Finance Park “simulation,”** students are provided with electronic tablets, each assigned a different hypothetical life scenario. As they visit the various businesses featured in the simulation, students gain a better understanding of how different life and income circumstances affect decisions regarding expenses, savings, and investments. They develop and commit to a budget, just as an adult should. This process is guided by experienced and knowledgeable volunteers, staff and educators.

STUDENT’S JOURNEY THROUGH THE JA FINANCE PARK SIMULATION



ASSIGNMENT OF A LIFE SCENARIO: GLIMPING INTO ADULTHOOD

- At the start of the day, each student receives a digital tablet that presents them with **a life scenario** that includes a job, salary, credit score, and particular family situation.
- They will calculate their **Net Monthly Income (NMI)** and **plan their budget** to take care of themselves and their potential families.

INTERACTIVE DECISION MAKING PROCESS: TESTING SKILLS

- Students walk through the simulated city, visiting each business, **understanding each expense category**, to determine if it is **a need or a want**.
- Students shop around, pay bills, make purchases, open bank accounts, apply for an auto loan and mortgage, and much more, trying to make **educated decisions!**

VOLUNTEER GUIDANCE: SAFE FINANCIAL DECISION MODELING

- Students are **assisted and guided by the volunteers** through the decision making process, **evaluating** the “wants” versus “needs” of all the different expense categories.
- Volunteers with students share their own real-life experiences, serving as **role models**, and showing them what may face in reality.

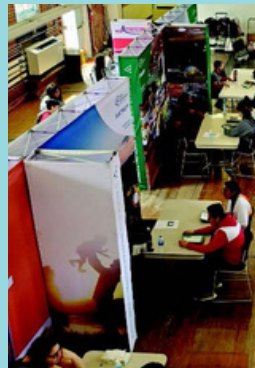
